Serger Decorator Pillow

This chic pillow is actually a study in decorative serger techniques. A band of serger pin tucks mimic the look of folded tucks, and a strip of piping inserted by serger separates two fabric panels; cover stitch is used as a topstitching on a narrow band with turned edges, and decorative chain stitch creates a diamond grid in contrasting thread. The resulting look is very stylish and easy to accomplish

INTRODUCTION TO SERGER

You must bring your own serger to class

- Serger with power cord
- All parts and accessories
- Manual and guides
- 4 different color serger threads unless have the Babylock Evolution, Evolve, Enlighten, or Imagine sergers then you can bring 4 spools of serger thread in the same color. We recommend and carry Maxi-Lock for all sergers.
- Small pair of scissors
- Serger tweezers (check your machine as many sergers come with tweezers)
- Needle threader if you have trouble seeing the eye of the needle and your serger does not have a needle threader.
